AFRICA AT ITS FINEST

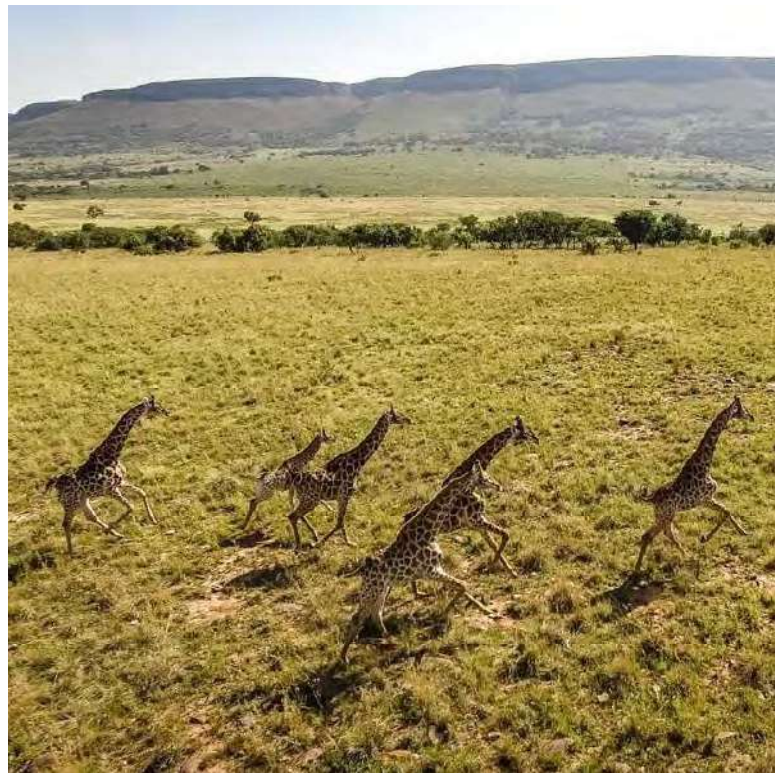
Situated on the Plumari Private Reserve in the Magaliesberg, just over an hour from Johannesburg or Pretoria and offering a memorable Wildlife Experience within a malaria-free environment. Set within a pristine wilderness of 6800 hectares with natural African Bushveld and an abundance of flora, fauna, bird and wildlife.





WELCOME TO AFRICAN HILLS SAFARI LODGE

African Hills Safari Lodge & Spa has one of the largest private collection of ox wagons, carts and other animal drawn vehicles from the period 1800 - 1900.



A variety of stone and iron-age artefacts, items from the SA War and San Bushmen rock carvings tell the history of the area, which is also known for the Battle of Nooitgedacht. Examples are available in the Museum and guided Bush Walks take guests through areas where many stone carvings (petroglyphs) can be found.





ACCOMMODATION

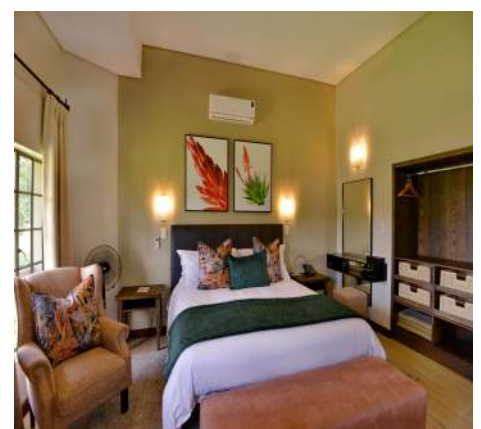

ACTIVITIES

African Hills Safari Lodge & Spa offers numerous activities.



Elephant Experiences

Get up close and personal with our resident elephants, Damara & Nzewe. This experience is a unique opportunity and starts with an educational talk followed by a “touch and feed” experience. It gives you the chance to learn about African Elephants, both wild and habituated as you interact and feed these gentle giants.

Game Drives

Plumari Private Reserve on which African Hills Safari Lodge & Spa is located is the closest Game Reserve to Johannesburg.

Our game viewing drives are available for morning and afternoon trips, as this is when the animals are most active.

You will be accompanied by a skilled ranger and guests can expect to encounter a diverse range of animals and bird species.

There are more than 20 species of larger animals, as well as several types of antelope and plains game, not to mention smaller species like antbears, hyena, porcupine and honey badgers. These drives make for spectacular viewing.



Mountain Hikes

Feel Africa underfoot on a guided bush walk with a trained game ranger over the varying terrains of the Reserve.

This experience offers an intimate encounter with nature and wildlife identifying medicinal and other plants en route as well as a variety of insects and birds.

Your guide will point out animal tracks, dung, hiding spots, rare birds and educate you on the history of the area.



Petroglyph Hikes

Discover rock carvings in what is said to be the oldest mountain range on Earth – the Magaliesberg.

Our accompanied hikes offer you the ideal opportunity to learn about the finest art created in pre-historic times. The artists who created these images lived and worked in this valley between Stone Age & Iron Age times (approx. 2000 – 500 years ago)

A short walk to the top of the hills reveals the skills of these people in their near perfect images of various animals with little more than a piece of metallic rock and at best, a crudely fashioned iron spike.

Geoheritage Tour

A tour around the highest point of the Magaliesberg Mountain Range, one of the oldest Mountain Ranges in the world. This is a hands-on experience of the geology, ancient stone tool workshop and pecked engravings where we visit a rain-making site which features a giant carved statue of a rain bull.



Nooitgedacht Battlefield Tour

We explore the Battlefield on and around Nooitgedacht Mountain, the highest point of the Magaliesberg Mountain Range in a game drive vehicle, where the biggest battle of the guerilla phase of the Anglo-Boer War was fought on 13th December 1900. You are driven between battlefield highlights, where we walk to various features – including forts, sangars and heliograph stations – on cut and well maintained paths.

CONFERENCES

Our five conference rooms are situated in the Day Visitors Centre which is abundant with African symbology, rich earthy colours and unique African décor focal points.

A wooden deck affords you great views of the Magaliesberg range and the reserve.
